# Pet Import Process

## • Before departure

1. Send all the required documents\* through email to [qsap\\_bkk@dld.go.th](mailto:qsap_bkk@dld.go.th) (scan the documents as pdf or jpg) —

2. Call the quarantine station to confirm if your email is well received.

3. The scanned import permit is sent to you via email within 7 working days (In case of incomplete documents, more days are required)

4. Apply for an official health certificate with the authorized body of the exporting country responsible for the import and export of animals

## • At Arrival Process

5. Take your pets to the animal quarantine station. In the case that Suvarnabhumi Airport is your port of entry, there are two animal quarantine stations. You must go to the station as per your pet travel options as follows;

- Your pet travelling in the passenger cabin and coming in through the passenger terminal, please go to the animal quarantine station located near the baggage belt no.8 in the arrival hall (Tel. +66 2134 0636)
- Your pet travelling as checked baggage and loaded at the cargo terminal, please go to International Animal Quarantine Station (AQS) located on the 1st floor, CE-1 Building, Free Zone area.

- 1) a photocopy of pet owner's passport
- 2) an original pet vaccination record (and a pet passport, if any)
- 3) an original official health certificate\*
- 4) a photocopy of printed import permit

# Required documents for pet import

1. Import License Application Form (Form R.1/1)

2. Copy of the pet owner's passport (Picture page)

3. Proof of Vaccination:

- o Pets is vaccinated against Rabies not less than 21 days prior to the departure. Pets from free of Rabies certified country do not need a Rabies vaccination.
- o Pet is vaccinated against Leptospirosis not less than 21 days prior to the departure. The negative result of Leptospirosis test during 30 days prior to the departure can also fulfill the requirement.

4. Picture of the pet (The picture must be in color and the pet face must be clearly seen.)

5. Document which provides following information:

- o Number and species of the pets
- o Details of the pets (breed, sex, age, color, and microchip of each pet)
- o Address of the country of origin
- o Address of your accommodation in Thailand

The import permit is valid for 60 days

- The import license (Form R.7) is valid for 7 days
  - The Official health Certificate must be completed in English and stamped (endorsed) by the authorized veterinary official of the exporting country.
- The animal must be conveyed in nose-and-paw proof crates designed to avoid any risk of injury.

# Requirements for the importation of dogs and cats into the Kingdom of Thailand



## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF DOGS AND CATS INTO THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND**

- 1) **A health certificate** in English, signed or further endorsed by a full-time authorized veterinary official of the government of the exporting country, if it is previously acknowledged by a veterinary surgeon, stating:-
  - 1.1) number and species ,
  - 1.2) breed, sex, age and color or animal identification,
  - 1.3) name and address of the owner **OR** the kennel of origin,
  - 1.4) certification of condition items (2) to (5).
- 2) The animals must come from an area where animal diseases are under control. They are found to be healthy, free from signs of any infectious and contagious diseases including ectoparasitism at the time of export and fit to travel.
- 3) The country has been free from Rabies for at least the past 12 (twelve) months **OR** the animals are vaccinated against Rabies with an official approved vaccine not less than 21 (twenty- one) days prior to the departure.
- 4) **EITHER** a) The dog is vaccinated against Leptospirosis at least 21(twenty-one) days preceding departure.  
**OR** b) The dog is subjected to a test for Leptospirosis with negative result during the 30 (thirty) days prior to the departure.
- 5) The animals shall be vaccinated against other significant infectious or contagious diseases i.e. Distemper, Hepatitis, and Parvovirus, with an official approved vaccine at least 21 (twenty-one) days prior to the departure.
- 6) The animals must be conveyed in nose-and-paw proof crates designed to avoid any risk of injury or unnecessary suffering.
- 7) The animals are not allowed to expose to other animals if they have to be landed in transit at any approved intermediate port. They shall not be allowed to leave precinct of the port except to an officially approved transit quarantine area.
- 8) The animals are subjected to quarantine at approved premises for a period of at least 30 (thirty) days upon arrival during which they shall be submitted to tests and/or treatments deemed necessary. The importer/owner shall be fully charged for the incurred expenses.
- 9) Failure to follow the import procedures may result in returning the animals to the country of origin or destroying without compensation.
